Brief Curriculum Vitae (CV 2009)

Education: Born in Zagreb on June 15, 1963. Graduate studies: Zagreb University (Croatia), Johannes Gutenberg University, Mainz (Germany). Graduated from University of Zagreb - Faculty of Philosophy (B.A. degrees in philosophy and comparative literature) and Faculty of Law (dipl. iur. degree in 1988). Postgraduate studies: Zagreb University, University of Vienna, Austria (Visiting Fellow, 1992, 1995), Harvard Law School, USA (Fulbright Visiting Researcher, 1996). Postgraduate degrees received from Zagreb University - Master of Laws, 1992 and Doctor of Laws, 1999.

Current engagements: Dr. Uzelac is currently employed as Professor of Procedural Law at the Zagreb University, Faculty of Law, where he teaches Civil Procedure, Arbitration, ADR, Judiciary, Evidence and Protection of Human Rights in Europe. He is involved in various activities of the European Commission for the Efficiency of Justice (CEPEJ) of the Council of Europe, where he held different functions (Bureau member from 2003-2006, Member – national delegate 2003-2008; President of the Task Force on Timeframes of Proceedings of the CEPEJ 2005-2006); Member of the SATURN Group de pilotage 2007-2008. Since mid-90s, Dr. Uzelac has also been engaged as national delegate of Croatia in the work of UNCITRAL Working Group for Arbitration and Conciliation.

Professional experience: Internship at Zagreb Municipal and County Courts, 1990-1992. Croatian State Bar Examination - admitted to the Bar, Zagreb, 1992. Internship at the Secretariat of the ICC International Court of Arbitration in Paris (France) in 1992. From 1992-2002 Dr. Uzelac was Secretary General of the Permanent Arbitration Court at the Croatian Chamber of Commerce, where he was engaged in administering more than 350 cases (about 200 domestic and 150 international). Among other duties, Dr. Uzelac has been a Member of the Executive Board of the Croatian Arbitration Association and co-editor of the Croatian Arbitration Yearbook. He is a member of panels of a number of arbitration institutions where he occasionally acts as arbitrator in international cases.

Legislative and drafting activity: Dr. Uzelac was engaged in drafting of a number of documents in his home country and international bodies. In Croatia he was the principal drafter or engaged in the drafting of the following acts: Law on Courts; Law on State Judicial Council; Arbitration Law; Conciliation Law; Court Rule Book; Legal Aid Act. He is also member of the national Commission for the Administration of the Internet national top-level domain (.hr) and author of the Rules for DNS Arbitral Dispute Resolution regarding .hr domain names.

Teaching and training engagements: Great number of speaking, lecturing and training engagements in a number of countries (mostly in Europe).

Publications: Three books and a number of papers, on the topics of organization of the justice system; efficiency and fairness of justice; arbitration and alternative dispute resolution; legal professions; enforcement; law of evidence and comparative law.
