

PROF. DR. SC. ALAN UZELAC - Brief Curriculum Vitae (CV 2025)

Alan Uzelac is Professor of Law and Head of Department for Civil Procedure at the Zagreb University, where he teaches Civil Procedure, Comparative Law, Organization of Justice, Arbitration, ADR and Protection of Human Rights in Europe. He holds degrees in law (LL.B., LL.M., LL.D.) and social sciences (M.A. (phil.), M.A. (literature)) from Zagreb University. He is a visiting researcher and guest lecturer at a number of universities, including Harvard Law School (Fulbright grant), and universities of Vienna (Austria), Maastricht (the Netherlands), Peking (China), Oslo and Bergen (Norway), Moscow, Kazan and Yekaterinburg (Russia), Kyiv (Ukraine), Budapest (Hungary), Uppsala (Sweden), Pretoria and Stellenbosch (South Africa), Curitiba, Rio, Belo Horizonte, Porto Alegre and Vitoria (Brazil), Santiago and Concepcion (Chile), La Plata and Tucuman (Argentina), Milano and Pavia (Italy) and Ljubljana and Maribor (Slovenia). As an active member of the International Association of Procedural Law and the German Association for International Procedural Law, he has been serving on the chief advisory bodies of both organizations. Dr. Uzelac was among the founders of the European Commission for the Efficiency of Justice (CEPEJ) of the Council of Europe, where he held different functions (*inter alia*: Bureau member from 2003-2006, President of the Task Force on Timeframes of Proceedings – TF-DEL 2005-2006). He has published over 100 papers in various international and national publications, edited over 10 books published by reputable international publishers and wrote several books on topical issues of procedural law. As an international expert he worked in the region and Europe, assisting legal reforms and legal collaboration in Bulgaria, Serbia, Kosovo, Georgia, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Montenegro, Russia, Ukraine, Morocco, Armenia and Azerbaijan. He is also active as arbitrator and expert in international commercial and investment cases.
